What is a System?



A system is a mechanism that consistently produces and maintains an outcome. The mechanism is designed by the collective values, worldviews and priorities of its developer to achieve specific outcomes.

How we think about services. How we organize services. How we deliver services.








Impact of Systems Thinking



- Talk about successes and defend the vision








From Person Centered Planning to Person Centered Systems!


