


Using Closed Captioning



KNOWING EACH PERSON:

When thinking about the future it is important that all plans accurately reflect the youth's personality, interest, experiences, and goals for the future. Every TD plan is personalized with vision boards and personalized plans and vision boards are all built by considering youth's STRENGTHS, experiences, interests and goals for the future.





TRANSITION DISCOVERIES is a strategic partner with the George Washington University, the hub of our research, our implementation model, and our pillars.


• We collected experiences from more than 500 youth with disabilities, their families and professionals


